



Joint L.A and San Diego Trip

Come join SAGA at our Fall outing to the El Prado Group Camp, located at 5,500 feet in the Laguna Recreation area of the Cleveland National Forest. Situated east of San Diego, the Laguna Mountain range supports a forest of Jeffrey pines and black oaks. SAGA's camping trips provide a chance to escape the fast pace of the city, and this trip offers beautiful vistas in a portion of Southern California unfamiliar to most non-native Angelinos.

The campsite is surrounded by a canopy of trees, and is situated next to a large meadow area. Hiking is plentiful in the area. The site features running water, tables and vault toilets, adjacent parking, and is accessible to most trailers and campers in addition to tents.

This is our third three night trip, with an option for two nights. Both two and three night options include all meals and beverages, beginning with a Thursday evening dinner, and concluding with a Sunday Brunch. The cost remains low: \$120 for three nights or \$95 for two nights, members or guests. Full refund if you cancel by the deadline.

The Weekend:

Thursday evening: The campsite is ours after 2 P.M. The three night option starts Thursday with cocktails, a dinner and a raging campfire (subject to fire restrictions).

Friday: Hot coffee and a breakfast will be provided for the three nighters. Afterward, you can partake in Day hikes and/or just relax. We'll also set out a lunch for the three nighters, with beer and soda, suitable for packing on a hike or eating later in camp. Late afternoon, the men are usually in the shower freshening up. The two nighters join the three nighters at a festive cocktail party, followed by a full dinner. After dessert, join the group around the campfire (if USFS permits), or check out the moonlight and stars and...

Saturday: Hot coffee and breakfast will be provided. Afterward, you can partake in Day hikes and/or just relax. We'll also set out another lunch suitable for packing on a hike or eating later in camp. Later in the afternoon the shower will again be available, followed by another cocktail party and a full dinner.

Sunday: Coffee and juice will be available for early risers. During the morning, relax and enjoy nature. Around 9:00 a Brunch will be served. The site is ours only through 11 AM.

What to Take:

Campsites have running water, vault toilets, tables and benches and many tent sites. SAGA will set up a temporary Shower stall on Friday and Saturday afternoons. The campsite is spacious, and since it is a group site, it is fairly private.

Necessities: Sleeping bag, coffee mug, foam pad or air mattress (or travel trailer, RV, etc.); towels, comfortable waking shoes, walkers, warm clothing, water bottle or canteen for hiking, flashlight and poncho or rain gear.

Desirable: tent, pillow, folding chair, extra shoes and clothing, day pack, insect repellent, hat and camera. Sleeping bags and tents may be rented at some sporting goods stores.

Driving Directions to the camp and a list of campers and their assignments will be e-mailed to all participants just prior to the trip, around September 12, 2025
